Dear Church Family,

Thanks be to God! We have finally arrived at the place where we can begin in-person gatherings! **If the Lord wills, our plan is to begin on June 7th offering two morning services, one at 9:00 a.m. for those 65 and over and the vulnerable, and the second service at 10:30 a.m. for everyone else.** We would ask that those that have a fever or cold/flu symptoms stay home and tune into our recorded service.

Our goal is to gradually provide opportunities for gathering where we may be nourished and encouraged together in the presence of the Lord corporately while being safe and considerate of the well-being of others.

To that end, some things you should expect:

- We will ask that everyone enter the building at the First Street entrance and at the conclusion of the service we will ask everyone to exit via the Douglas Street doors.
- We will practice social distancing by using half of our seating - occupying only every other row of chairs. Family units are encouraged to sit together. No nursery will be provided.
- We will strive to maintain, as much as possible, a touch-free environment. For example, we will not be greeting in the traditional way, handing out bulletins, passing the offering plate, etc.
- Those in attendance will be asked to use their own discretion with respect to face coverings.

We have learned in this time the need to be flexible and accepting to change. These plans are tentative and will be evaluated for adjustment until we arrive at a new normal together for the glory of God.
